

**TOWN OF BELGIUM
ANNUAL MEETING
May 12, 2020**

Call to Order: The 172nd Annual Meeting of the Town of Belgium was held on Tuesday, May 12, 2020, in the Town Hall at 171 Main Street, Belgium. Chairperson Tom Winker called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Pledge of Allegiance recited. Quorum established. Verification of compliance with WI Open Meetings Law.

2019 Annual Report:

The Town of Belgium 2019 Annual Report was examined. Motion Poss/Feyereisen to accept the 2019 Annual Report as presented. In favor: 7 Opposed: 0

Resident Survey: Carlie Parks explained the option to survey town residents to aid in establishing land use plans and policies. The survey will be conducted before the comprehensive plan is revisited in 2025 and most likely be performed by UW Extension at a cost unknown at this time.

2021 Annual Meeting: Scheduled for April 20, 2021.

Board of Review: Board of Review is scheduled for Tuesday, June 9, 2020.

Citizen Input: Tom Winker followed up 2019's annual meeting reporting the town has hired a new attorney. State road aid is estimated to decline as much as 30% over the next three years due to decreased road use funds during COVID-19. Tom Bichler reiterated the electronics recycle event is on May 16th with a 'no contact' process in place. Bill Janeshek reiterated planned projects for the 2020 road construction season. He also presented a thank you note from David & Mary Shaw expressing their gratitude for road work on Homestead Dr. to alleviate water run-off problems. Janice Poss also expressed gratitude to the town board for their efforts.
