

**PUBLIC HEARING
TOWN BOARD MEETING MINUTES
September 7, 2021**

Call to Order Public Hearing: Chairperson Winker called to order public hearing for comments concerning adoption of Ordinance 2021-01, All-Terrain and Utility-Terrain Vehicle Ordinance at 7:00 pm. with approximately 29 people in attendance.

Residents requested Lakeshore ATV/UTV Club contact information be added to the Town's website and the DNR contact information on the Club's website. Complaints will be reviewed annually. Residents questioned regulation of the number of riders in a group and business use of ATV/UTVs. These issues were not discussed and not included in the ordinance. The vehicles will adhere to posted speed limits, and the only accessible County roads are those with a speed limit of 35 mph or less. Signage expense and installation will be covered by the Lakeshore ATV/UTV Club. The ordinance is not in effect until signage has been installed.

Adjourn: The public hearing was adjourned at 7:14

Call to Order Town Board Meeting: Chairperson Tom Winker called the Town Board Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Quorum established. Pledge of Allegiance recited. Verification of compliance with WI Open Meetings Law.

In Attendance: Supervisors Bill Janeshek and Tom Bichler, Clerk Ginger Murphy, Zoning Administrator Charlie Parks, and 27 interested persons, and Mitch Maersch from the *Ozaukee Press* and Rodney Schroeter from the *Sounder*. Treasurer Dayle Parks not present.

Minutes: Motion Janeshek/Bichler to approve the minutes of the August Town Board meeting; all voted in favor.

Zoning Permits: Charlie Parks reported zoning permits issued in August:

#13 Garrett & Kayla Schwablender, 595 Jay Rd - New residence

(will live in existing house until the new home is completed, then it will be removed)

#14 Pat & Louise Hillegas, 6401 Silver Beach S – Detached garage

Roads: Luxembourg Lane was seal coated. Ditches will be cut in 2-3 weeks.

Transfer Site: Tom Bichler reported inefficiencies with Waste Management. It was decided to monitor over the next few months. If service doesn't improve, the Town will seek a new collection company.

ATV/UTV Ordinance 2021-01: Motion Bichler/Janeshek to approve Ordinance 2021-01, All-Terrain and Utility-Terrain Vehicle Ordinance. All voted in favor; motion carried.

Certified Survey Map - Risch: Map not yet available.

Certified Survey Map – Ansay: Motion Janeshek/Bichler to approve CSM as presented; all voted in favor.

Town Property Deed on Sandy Beach: Tom Winker gave an overview of the issue: He explained the property deeded to the Town for possible creation of a road. Ash trees on property died, were cut, and a neighboring property owner planted new trees on the property owned by the Town. Ralph Weber thought he had permission from Charlie Parks to plant the trees; Charlie Parks apologized for not being able to recall that conversation. The Town Board directed the removal of the newly planted trees within one year. Nate Altheimer presented a letter sent to Lakeview Ridge residents from the Sandy Beach S residents asking to keep the trees in place. Altheimer said he wants to see the trees gone before frost this year and asked to change the motion. Bill Janeshek stated the board is fine with the initial decision. The land was deeded to the town for a reason and have no plans to do anything with the property.

Snow Removal at Town Hall: The Clerk was instructed to request bids for snow removal at town hall to be addressed at the November town board meeting.

County Redistricting Map: Motion Winker/Bichler approve the supervisory redistricting map. All voted in favor.

Citizen Input: Janice Poss asked about dead ash. Janeshek stated the trees are being removed eventually as time allows and stated tree cutting is more of a winter project for the County Highway Dept. Another resident asked for a plan regarding removal of dead trees, and Winker asked put the issue on PC agenda. Dan Large asked about grant \$ and how much the town spent.

Audit the Bills: Monthly invoices were audited and ordered paid.

Adjourn: The Town Board meeting adjourned at 8:20.
